William Byrd, *Sing joyfully* - Byrd worked at Lincoln cathedral

Thomas Tallis, *If ye love me* - Katherine Parr, wife of Edward, son of Lord Burgh, then later wife of Henry VIII knew Tallis and co-wrote music with him

Robert Parsons, *Ave maria* - local Lincolnshire singer and composer

Henry VIII, *Pastime with good company* - Henry VIII visited Gainsborough Old Hall

Samuel Sebastian Wesley, *Blessed be the God and father* - S.S. Wesley is the grandson of Charles Wesley, brother to John Wesley who is known to have preached at Old Hall

Johannes Brahms, *Wie lieblich* - text of this piece is 'How lovely is thy dwelling place...'

Anton Bruckner, *Locus iste* - text of this piece is 'This place was made by God'

arr. John Rutter, *Sprig o' Thyme, Cuckoo, Afton water* - Sprig o' Thyme is thought to be a Lincolnshire folk tune

arr. Percy Grainger, *Brigg fair* - another Lincolnshire folk tune

arr. Charles Harrison, *Lincolnshire poacher* - another Lincolnshire folk tune!
